Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that a paramedic who is appointed by the Governor as a member of the Paramedicine Council of New South Wales must be a paramedic nominated by the Minister administering the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW)*.

This Regulation is made under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW)*, including sections 41E and 247A (the general regulation-making power).
