## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to change the amounts payable under a penalty notice for certain offences under the *National Parks and Wildlife Regulation 2009*, so as to standardise those amounts across legislation that regulates conduct at certain public places.

This Regulation is made under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*, including sections 154 (the general regulation-making power) and 192 (Penalty notice for certain offences).

### **1 Name of Regulation**
