## **Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts— Amendment No 1) Order 2019**

under the

Constitution Act 1902

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 1) Order 2019*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Allocation of the administration of Acts**

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers indicated in that Schedule.

**Note.** See section 15 of the *Interpretation Act 1987* for the interpretation of references to “the Minister” in an Act.

- (2) The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by this Order.
- (3) To remove any doubt, the allocation by this Order of the *Roads Act 1993* to the Minister for Transport and Roads does not affect the joint administration of that Act with the Minister for Regional Transport and Roads.
