## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to change the amounts payable under a penalty notice for certain offences under the *Western Sydney Parklands Regulation 2013*, so as to standardise those amounts across legislation that regulates conduct at certain public places.

This Regulation is made under the *Western Sydney Parklands Act 2006*, including sections 48 (Penalty notices) and 50 (the general regulation-making power).

clause 18 (1) (c)—act (other than by driving, riding or parking a vehicle) contrary to a sign approved by the Trust that regulates the movement of vehicles or animals	\$112
clause 18 (1) (c)—park a vehicle contrary to a sign approved by the Trust that regulates the parking of vehicles or the confinement of animals	\$80
