Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Passenger Transport (Opal and Other Fares) Order 2016* to specify maximum fares for the following services (supplied in accordance with an approved payment device):

- (a) off-peak rail passenger services (other than light rail services),
- (b) bus services.

This Order is made under section 125 of the Passenger Transport Act 2014.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the Passenger Transport (Opal and Other Fares) Amendment (Approved Payment Devices) Order 2019.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 29 July 2019 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Passenger Transport (Opal and Other Fares) Order 2016

(1) Schedule 1 Fares

Omit the matter relating to "Approved payment device" from Part 1. Insert instead:

Approved payment device	Peak full fare	Off-peak full fare
Train—distance band 1	\$3.61	\$2.52
Train—distance band 2	\$4.48	\$3.13
Train—distance band 3	\$5.15	\$3.60
Train—distance band 4	\$6.89	\$4.82
Train—distance band 5	\$8.86	\$6.20
Maximum default fare for failure to tap on or off	\$8.86	\$6.20

Note. The fares include travel on rail replacement bus services, including in Newcastle.

Insert at the end of Part 3:

Approved payment device	Full fare
Bus—distance band 1	\$2.24
Bus—distance band 2	\$3.73
Bus—distance band 3	\$4.80
Maximum default fare for failure to tap on or off	\$4.80
