## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to enable the Chief Executive Officer (*CEO*) of Service NSW to sub-delegate customer service functions lawfully delegated to the CEO by a Government agency or other person to Mid North Coast Local Health District (a local health district constituted under the *Health Services Act 1997*).

This Regulation is made under the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013*, including sections 7(3)(b) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).
