Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014* to update references to infection control standards in certain policies and guidelines referred to in that Regulation.

This Regulation is made under the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2007*, including sections 10 and 71 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Amendment (Infection Control Standards) Regulation 2019*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014

(1) Clause 8 Infection control standards: section 10

Insert “*Prevention and*” after “*Infection*” in clause 8(a).

(2) Clause 8(b)

Omit “6.4”. Insert instead “5.2.4”.
