Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Combat Sports Regulation 2014* to exempt any Judo held under the rules of and sanctioned by the International Budo Federation from the operation of the *Combat Sports Act 2013*.

This Regulation is made under the *Combat Sports Act 2013*, including sections 4(1) (definition of *combat sport*) and 106 (the general regulation-making power).
