Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to add carbapenemase-producing *Enterobacterales* infection and colonisation to the list of Category 3 medical conditions under the *Public Health Act 2010*, which will require pathology laboratories to notify the Secretary of the Ministry of Health of any positive test results for that condition.

This Order is made under section 51 (2) of the *Public Health Act 2010*.
