The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Holidays Order 2011* to revoke the declaration of a half-day public holiday from 12 midday on 27 March 2020 for the Muswellbrook Shire Council area, as the event that was to be held on that day (the Muswellbrook Cup) will no longer be open to the public.
