Explanatory note

The object of this Rule is to amend the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* for the following purposes—

- (a) to provide for judgments and orders to be taken to be entered when a document embodying the judgment or order is signed and sealed by a judicial officer,
- (b) to assign certain business under the *Public Works and Procurement Act 1912* to the commercial list of the equity division of the Supreme Court.
