Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Holidays Order 2011* to revoke the declaration of public holidays in May 2020 in certain parts of the Cabonne Shire Council and Clarence Valley Council areas, and in the Bogan Shire Council and Coonamble Shire Council areas. In response to the *Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order 2020*, the agricultural shows originally scheduled for each of those areas have been cancelled.

Clause 4 Public holidays for a specified part of the State

Omit the following from the table to the clause—

That part of Yeoval that is situated within the Cabonne Shire Council area	Part-day from 8.30 am to 7 pm on 12 May 2020
Bogan Shire Council area	Half-day from 12 midday on 18 May 2020
Police Patrol Districts of Maclean, Yamba and Iluka within the Clarence Valley Council area	Part-day from 12 midday to 5 pm on 20 May 2020
Coonamble Shire Council area	27 May 2020
