Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Act 2017*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Regulation 2017*—

- (a) to enable the Chief Executive to levy a contribution to the Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Fund on proprietors of certain coal mines, but no more than once a year, and
- (b) to specify the amount of those contributions.

This Regulation is made under the *Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Act 2017*, including sections 33 and 51 (the general regulation-making power).

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Amendment (Contributions) Regulation 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Coal Mine Subsidence Compensation Regulation 2017

[1] Clause 10 Contributions under section 33

Omit clause 10(3). Insert instead—

- (3) For any calendar year, the Chief Executive must not levy more than 1 contribution in respect of a particular coal mine.
