## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare certain substances to be gases for the purposes of the *Gas and Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2017*.

This Regulation is made under the *Gas and Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2017*, including the definition of **gas** in section 4(1) and section 75 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Gas and Electricity (Consumer Safety) Amendment (Medical Gas Work) Regulation 2020*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 1 November 2020 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Gas and Electricity (Consumer Safety) Regulation 2018**

#### **Clause 3A**

Insert after clause 3—

#### **3A Definition of “gas”—section 4(1)**

The following substances are declared to be gases for the purposes of the Act—

- (a) oxygen,
- (b) nitrous oxide,
- (c) helium,
- (d) nitrogen,
- (e) carbon dioxide,
- (f) medical air,
- (g) surgical tool gas,
- (h) common mixtures of the gases referred to in paragraphs (a) to (g),
- (i) waste anaesthetic gas.
