Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health Act 2010* to—

- (a) add Silicosis to the list of medical conditions in Schedule 1 to that Act that must be notified by medical practitioners to the Secretary of the Ministry of Health, and
- (b) add *Candida auris* infection and colonisation to the list of medical conditions in Schedule 1 to that Act that must be notified by pathology laboratories to the Secretary of the Ministry of Health.
