1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 5) Order 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at 4 pm on 3 July 2020.

3 Allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers indicated in that Schedule.
- (2) The administration of Acts or parts of Acts that directly amend other Acts are allocated to the Ministers administering the Act amended.
- (3) The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by this Order.

Note. See section 15 of the *Interpretation Act 1987* for the interpretation of references to “the Minister” in an Act.

4 Amendment of allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The entry relating to the “Special Minister of State, Minister for the Public Service and Employee Relations, Aboriginal Affairs, and the Arts” is to follow the entry relating to the “Minister for Regional Transport and Roads”.
- (2) Relocate the entry relating to the “Vice-President of the Executive Council” to follow the entry relating to the “Special Minister of State, Minister for the Public Service and Employee Relations, Aboriginal Affairs, and the Arts”.
- (3) Relocate the entry relating to the “Attorney General, and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic Violence” to follow the entry relating to the “Vice-President of the Executive Council”.
- (4) Relocate the entry relating to the “Minister for Finance and Small Business” to follow the entry relating to the “Attorney General, and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic Violence”.
- (5) Relocate the entry relating to the “Minister for Roads and Transport” to follow the entry relating to the “Minister for Customer Service”.
