

# **Assisted Reproductive Technology Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2020**

under the

Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2007

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2007*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014—

- (a) to increase (from \$2,821 to \$2,869) the application fee for the registration of an ART provider, and
- (b) to increase (from \$1,997 to \$2,031) the annual registration fee payable by a registered ART provider. This Regulation is made under the *Assisted Reproductive Technology Act 2007*, including sections 7(2) and (8) and 71 (the general regulation-making power).

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Assisted Reproductive Technology Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2020.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

#### 3 Amendment of Assisted Reproductive Technology Regulation 2014

(1) Clause 4 Registration application fee: section 7(2)

Omit "\$2,821". Insert instead "\$2,869".

(2) Clause 6 Annual registration fee: section 7(8)

Omit "\$1,997" from clause 6(1). Insert instead "\$2,031".
