Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

The Scientific Committee established under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* has made a final determination under Division 3 of Part 4 of that Act (as applied by section 4.33) to reject a proposal to list the cascading effects of the loss or removal of dingoes from NSW landscapes as a key threatening process.
