Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Holidays Order 2011* to revoke the declaration of a part-day public holiday from 12 midday to 6 pm on 2 September 2020 for certain parts of the Bland Shire local government area, as the agricultural show scheduled for that day has been cancelled because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
