## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the periods during which temporary changes to the accrual and taking of long service leave as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic have effect.

This Regulation is made under the *Long Service Leave Act 1955*, including sections 15 (the general regulation-making power), 15A(4) (definition of *prescribed period*), 15B(3) (definition of *prescribed period*) and 15C(3) (definition of *prescribed period*).

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Long Service Leave Amendment (COVID-19 Prescribed Period) Regulation 2020*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Amendment of Long Service Leave Regulation 2016

#### Clause 4A

Insert after clause 4—

#### 4A COVID-19 pandemic—extension of prescribed period

- (1) The *prescribed period* referred to in section 15A(4) of the Act ends on 24 March 2021.
- (2) The *prescribed period* referred to in section 15B(3) of the Act ends on 13 May 2021.
- (3) The *prescribed period* referred to in section 15C(3) of the Act ends on 12 March 2021.
