Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period during which meetings of the Executive Council may be held in person or by means of a teleconference or video conference because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

This Regulation is made under the *Constitution Act 1902*, including clauses 1 (definition of *prescribed period*) and 4 of Schedule 8.
