Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period during which special statutory provisions, enacted in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, permit alternative ways for association meetings and ballots to occur. This Regulation is made under the *Associations Incorporation Act 2009*, including section 107 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 17 (definition of *prescribed period*) of Schedule 4.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Associations Incorporation Amendment (COVID-19 Prescribed Period) Regulation 2020*.

22 COVID-19 pandemic—extension of prescribed period

The *prescribed period* referred to in Schedule 4, clause 17 to the Act ends at the end of 25 March 2021.
