Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make minor amendments to the *Public Health Regulation 2012* consequential on the making of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) 2020*, which is proposed to commence at the beginning of 2 October 2020, to update the types of offences that may be dealt with by way of penalty notice.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 2010*, including sections 118 and 134 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Public Health Amendment (COVID-19 Border Control) Regulation (No 2) 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the commencement of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) 2020* and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Public Health Regulation 2012

Schedule 4 Penalty notice offences

Omit the matters relating to “Section 10, for an offence against clause 6 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order 2020*” and “Section 10, for an offence against clause 8B or 8C of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order 2020*” from Part 1.

Insert in appropriate order—
