

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Health Legislation Amendment* Act 2018 that amend the *Health Administration Act 1982* to establish new procedures for dealing with reportable incidents and other incidents and to make a consequential amendment to the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* to protect information arising from reviews of those incidents.
