## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to declare *Murray Valley Wine Grape Industry Development (Extraterritorial) Order 2020* of Victoria to be a recognised foundation instrument for the purposes of the *Agricultural Industry Services Act 1998*.

This Regulation is made under the *Agricultural Industry Services Act 1998*, including sections 32D and 51 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Agricultural Industry Services Amendment (Recognised Foundation Instrument) Regulation 2020*.

### **3 Amendment of Agricultural Industry Services Regulation 2015**

#### **(1) Clause 16, heading**

Omit the heading. Insert instead—

**16 Declaration of Murray Valley Wine Grape Industry Development (Extraterritorial) Order 2020 (Vic) as recognised foundation instrument**

#### **(2) Clause 16(1)**

Omit “*(Extra-territorial) Order 2016*”.

Insert instead “*(Extraterritorial) Order 2020*”.
