

Civil Procedure Amendment (Fees) Regulation (No 2) 2020

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Civil Procedure Act 2005*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Civil Procedure Regulation 2017 as follows—

- (a) to provide that the fees for hearing of proceedings before associate judges of the Supreme Court and judges of the Supreme Court are the same,
- (b) to increase the fee payable upon receipt by the registrar of a document or thing produced in compliance with a notice to produce under Part 34 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* to ensure it is the same as the fee for issuing a subpoena,
- (c) to introduce a fee for the issuing of a notice to produce under Part 34 of the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005* with the fee being the same as the fee for issuing a subpoena,
- (d) to introduce a fee payable for the cost of the registrar's determination on whether access should be permitted to a file or box of files retrieved where the file or box of files is retrieved from an off-site storage facility.

This Regulation is made under the Civil Procedure Act 2005, including section 18 (fees).

This Regulation is the Civil Procedure Amendment (Fees) Regulation (No 2) 2020.
