Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Members of Parliament Staff Act 2013* to add, as special office holders in Schedule 1, the Leader and Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Council and the Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly.

The amendment will enable the Leader and Deputy Leaders to employ staff on behalf of the State under a written agreement to assist in exercising the functions of their offices.

This Regulation is made under the *Members of Parliament Staff Act 2013*, including sections 15(3) and 27 (the general regulation-making power).
