Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Regulation 2020

under the

Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Act 1976

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Act 1976*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that the next election for councillors and delegates to the Federation of Parents and Citizens Associations of New South Wales is to be held before 31 August 2021. Usually, elections are held every 2 years.

This Regulation is made under the *Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Act 1976*, including sections 23F(a) and 24 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely, matters of a machinery nature.

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1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Regulation 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation—

the Act means the *Parents and Citizens Associations Incorporation Act 1976*.

Note. The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Regulation.

4 Election to be held before 31 August 2021

For the purposes of section 23F(a) of the Act, the first election after the commencement of this regulation is to be held before 31 August 2021.
