Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Public Health Regulation 2012* to prescribe the particulars that are required to be notified by a medical practitioner when attending a person with asbestosis.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 2010*, including sections 54(2)(a) and 134 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Public Health Amendment (Scheduled Medical Conditions—Asbestosis) Regulation 2020*.

3 Amendment of Public Health Regulation 2012

Clause 37 Notification of category 1 and 2 conditions

Insert after clause 37(h)—

- (i) in relation to asbestosis—the particulars required to be included in the *Asbestosis Notification Form* published by the Ministry of Health.
