Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to notify the number that equates to the factor $\frac{B}{C}$ used in the formula set out in section 3.22 of the *Motor Accident Injuries Act 2017* (*the Act*).

The number is used to calculate the variation of the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits to be paid to a person who has been injured in a motor accident to which the Act applies.

Section 3.22 of the Act requires the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits to be varied on 1 April and 1 October each year.

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1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Motor Accident Injuries (Indexation) Amendment Order 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 1 April 2021 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
