Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase certain fees imposed under various legislation relating to transport. The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index.

This Regulation is made under the following Acts—

- (a) *Driving Instructors Act 1992*, including sections 11(2), 30(2)(b) and 59 (the general regulation-making power),
- (b) *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including sections 19K(1), 37(2)(k) and 137 (the general regulation-making power),
- (c) *Photo Card Act 2005*, including sections 5(3) and 36 (the general regulation-making power),
- (d) *Ports and Maritime Administration Act 1995*, including sections 85G and 110 (the general regulation-making power),
- (e) *Road Transport Act 2013*, including sections 23 (the general statutory rule-making power) and 24 and Schedule 1.

Transport Legislation Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2021

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Transport Legislation Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 April 2021 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
