Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to exempt councils from a model code of meeting practice provision that requires personal attendance of councillors at certain meetings.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 748 (the general regulation-making power) and Schedule 6, clause 1.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Local Government (General) Amendment (Exemption) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Local Government (General) Regulation 2005

Clause 237

Insert after clause 236—

237 Exemption from requirement of code of meeting conduct—the Act, Schedule 6, clause 1

- (1) This clause applies to an area if the council for the area has adopted a code of meeting practice that includes model code, clause 5.2.
- (2) An area to which this clause applies is exempt from the Act, section 360(5) to the extent that the council, or a committee of the council of which all the members are councillors, is required to comply with the model code, clause 5.2, as adopted by the code of meeting practice.
- (3) This clause is repealed on 31 December 2021, at the end of the day.
- (4) In this clause—
model code means the code specified in clause 232.
