Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment Regulation 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are to—

- (a) amend the names of certain prohibited drugs for the purpose of more accurately describing the substance concerned, and
- (b) prescribe certain substances as precursors in the manufacture or production of prohibited drugs.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, including sections 24A(3) (the definition of *precursor*), 44(b) and 45 (the general regulation-making power).

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Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Amendment Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

- Methyl alpha-phenylacetoacetate (also known as MAPA)
- Methyl 3-(3',4'-Methylenedioxyphenyl)-2-methyl glycidate (also known as MMDMG)
- Methyl 3-phenyl-2-methyl glycidate
- 3-(3',4'-Methylenedioxyphenyl)-2-methyl glycidic acid (including salts)
- N-Phenethyl-4-piperidone (also known as NPP)
- 3-Phenyl-2-methyl glycidic acid (including salts)
- 1-Phenyl-2-propanone bisulphite
