The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* to list lisdexamfetamine and tapentadol as prohibited drugs.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, including sections 44 and 45 (the general regulation-making power).
