The object of this Regulation is to extend the operation of clause 175 of the *Workers Compensation Regulation 2016* for a period of 12 months.

This Regulation is made under the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*, including sections 44B(3)(a1) and 280 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Workers Compensation Amendment (Certificates of Capacity) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Workers Compensation Regulation 2016
