Explanatory note

The object of this By-law is to amend the *Southern Cross University By-law 2005* to remove the requirement on certain persons to preside at ceremonial occasions.

This By-law is made under the Southern Cross University Act 1993, including section 29, the general power to make by-laws.

1 Name of By-law
