Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986* to require the indictable offence of supplying prohibited drugs on an ongoing basis under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* to be dealt with summarily unless the prosecutor or person charged elects to have the offence dealt with on indictment.
