Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the fee to be paid to the Pharmacy Council of New South Wales when a person with a financial interest in a pharmacy business gives an annual declaration to the Council.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Health Practitioner Regulation (New South Wales) Amendment (Pharmacy Annual Declaration Fee) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Health Practitioner Regulation (New South Wales) Regulation 2016

Clause 15 Pharmacy Fees

Insert after clause 15(2)—

- (3) For the purposes of the Law, Schedule 5F, clause 15(1A), the prescribed amount, being the fee to accompany an annual declaration to the Council by a person who holds a financial interest in a pharmacy business, is \$297 per pharmacy business.
