1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Oaths Amendment (Identification) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Oaths Regulation 2017

(1) **Clause 6 Confirmation of identity of person not known to authorised witness**

Omit “paragraph (e)” from clause 6(2)(c). Insert instead “paragraph (l)”.

(2) **Clause 6(2)(c) and (d)**

Omit “clause 3” wherever occurring. Insert instead “clause 3(1)”.
