

Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2021

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Unlawful Gambling Act 1998*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal and remake, with minor changes, the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2016*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2021 by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, section 10(2).

The Regulation provides for the following—

- (a) the offences for which penalty notices may be issued and the amounts payable under the penalty
- (b) a class of persons who may issue penalty notices,
- (c) savings and formal matters.

This Regulation is made under the *Unlawful Gambling Act 1998*, including sections 52 and 57 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, namely—

- (a) matters of a machinery nature, and
- (b) matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Note. This Regulation repeals and replaces the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2016*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2021 by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, section 10(2).

3 Definition

In this Regulation—

the Act means the Unlawful Gambling Act 1998.

Note. The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Regulation.

4 Penalty notices—authorised officers

For the purposes of the definition of *authorised officer* in section 52(6) of the Act, police officers are specified in relation to all offences against the provisions specified in Schedule 1.

5 Repeal and savings

- (1) The *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2016* is repealed.
- (2) Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Unlawful Gambling Regulation 2016*, had effect under that Regulation continues to have effect under this Regulation.

Schedule 1 Penalty notice offences

1 Application of Schedule

- (1) For the purposes of section 52 of the Act—
 - (a) each offence created by a provision specified in this Schedule is an offence for which a penalty notice may be issued, and
 - (b) the amount payable for the penalty notice is the amount specified opposite the provision.
- (2) If the provision is qualified by words that restrict its operation to limited kinds of offences or to offences committed in limited circumstances, the penalty notice may be issued only for—
 - (a) that limited kind of offence, or
 - (b) an offence committed in those limited circumstances.
