## Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are—

- (a) to declare the Dust Diseases Tribunal and Industrial Relations Commission to be courts for the purposes of the *Electronic Transactions Act 2000*, Schedule 1, and
- (b) therefore, to facilitate the use of electronic case management systems in the courts.

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Electronic Transactions Amendment (DDT and IRC) Regulation 2021*.

### **2 Commencement**

For the purposes of the Act, Schedule 1, the following bodies are declared to be courts—

- (a) Civil and Administrative Tribunal,
- (b) Dust Diseases Tribunal,
- (c) Industrial Relations Commission,
- (d) Personal Injury Commission.
