Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to permit interstate applicants for a working with children check clearance who are members of the governing body of designated agencies, registered agencies and accredited adoption service providers to provide proof of identity in the way approved by the Children's Guardian.

This Regulation is made under the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012*, including sections 13(4)(b) and 52, the general regulation-making power.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Amendment (Proof of Identity) Regulation 2021*.

3 Amendment of Child Protection (Working with Children) Regulation 2013

Clause 18 Proof of identity

Insert after clause 18(3)(b)—

- (b1) a member of the governing body of an agency or service provider, referred to in clause 16B, who resides in another State or a Territory,
