Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable a penalty notice to be issued for the offence of failing to comply with a direction of the Minister for Health and Medical Research under the *Public Health Act 2010*, section 7 that applies to an occupier of a construction site in certain areas of Greater Sydney.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Public Health Amendment (COVID-19 Penalty Notice Offences) Regulation (No 2) 2021*.

3 Amendment of Public Health Regulation 2012

Schedule 4 Penalty notice offences

Omit the matter relating to “Section 10, for an offence of failing to comply with the direction in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Temporary Movement and Gathering Restrictions) Order 2021*, clause 24AC” under the heading “**Part 1 Offences under the Act**”.

Insert instead—

Section 10, for an offence of failing to comply with the direction in the <i>Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order 2021</i> , clause 24AC	\$2,000	\$10,000
Section 10, for an offence committed by an occupier of a construction site of failing to comply with the direction in the <i>Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order 2021</i> , clause 24EA	\$2,000	\$10,000
