Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to—

- (a) remove the *Disability Services Act 2006* of Queensland from the list of laws of another State or Territory prescribed for the purposes of information sharing provisions in the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (Worker Checks) Act 2018*, and
- (b) prescribe certain Acts, including the *Disability Services Act 2006* of Queensland, for the purposes of National Disability Insurance Scheme worker check clearances held under the law of another State or Territory.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (Worker Checks) Amendment Regulation 2021*.

- (g) *Worker Screening Act 2020* of Victoria.
