

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain amendments to the Local Government Act 1993 to—

- (a) remove certain procedural requirements from provisions relating to the integrated planning and reporting framework, and
- (b) enable regulations to be made about matters relating to community strategic plans, community engagement strategies, resourcing strategies, delivery programs, operational plans and certain reports, and
- (c) require councils to establish Audit, Risk and Improvement Committees, and
- (d) make other consequential amendments.
