

# Public Health Amendment (COVID-19 Delta Outbreak) Regulation 2021

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to update cross-references in provisions authorising the issue of penalty notices as a consequence of the remaking of an order under the *Public Health Act 2010*, section 7. This Regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 2010* including sections 118 and 134, the general

regulation-making power.

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Public Health Amendment (COVID-19 Delta Outbreak)* Regulation 2021.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

#### 3 Amendment of Public Health Regulation 2012

#### Schedule 4 Penalty notice offences

Omit all matter relating to section 10 of the Act. Insert instead—

Section 10, for an offence of failing to comply with a direction of the Minister in an order made under the Act, section 7—

- (a) for a direction to carry or wear a face covering—
  - (i) if the person who commits the offence is 18 years \$500 of age or older, or
  - (ii) if the person who commits the offence is 16 or 17 \$80 years of age, or
  - (iii) if the person who commits the offence is 15 years \$40 of age or younger, or
- (b) for a direction prohibiting coughing or spitting on a \$5,000 public official or other worker
- (c) for a direction under the following provisions of the Public Health (COVID-19 Additional Restrictions for Delta Outbreak) Order (No 2) 2021—

	(i) clause 3.18, 4.19 or 5.8,	\$2,000	\$10,000
	(ii) clause 3.13, 4.14, 5.3–5.6 or 6.4(5) or	(6), \$3,000	
	(iii) clause 6.2 or 6.3(1)(b) or (c), or	\$5,000	
(d)	for a direction under the <i>Public Health (COV Self-Isolation) Order (No 2) 2021</i> , or	YID-19 \$5,000	
(e)	for any other direction, if the offence occurs March 2020 and 31 December 2021	between 26 \$1,000	\$5,000
