Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Real Property Amendment (Certificates of Title) Act 2021*, other than schedule 1.2[9] which commenced on assent, to remove from the *Real Property Act 1900* and related legislation provisions requiring the Registrar-General to issue certificates of title and to take other action with certificates of title, including making a range of recordings on certificates and requiring the production of certificates of title for conveyancing transactions.
