1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administrative Changes—Miscellaneous) Order (No 2) 2021*.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website, except as provided by subclause (2).
- (2) Clause 4 is taken to have commenced on 1 May 2019.

3 Allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers indicated in the Schedule.
Note. See the *Interpretation Act 1987*, section 15 for the interpretation of references to “the Minister” in an Act.
- (2) The administration of Acts or parts of Acts that directly amend other Acts are allocated to the Ministers administering the Act amended.
- (3) The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by this Order.
- (4) This clause and Schedule 1 are repealed on the day following the day on which this clause commences.

Chief Executive Officer of the Environment Protection Authority. The Minister administering the *Protection of the Environment Administration Act 1991* is to exercise the employer functions of the Government in relation to the Chief Executive Officer and is to exercise the function of appointing or terminating the employment of the Chief Executive Officer in consultation with the Board of the Environment Protection Authority.
