Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period during which a worker's annual holidays continue to accrue despite being stood down without pay during that period as a direct or indirect result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Annual Holidays Amendment (COVID-19 Prescribed Period) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Annual Holidays Regulation 2021

Clause 4A

Insert after clause 4—

4A COVID-19 pandemic—definition of “prescribed period”

- (1) For the purposes of the Act, section 5A(3), definition of *prescribed period*, paragraph (b)(ii), 31 March 2022 is prescribed.
- (2) This clause is repealed on 1 April 2022.
