1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Interim Ministerial Changes) Order 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definitions

In this Order—

document means an Act or statutory or other instrument, or any contract or agreement.

Note. The *Constitution Act 1902*, Part 7 and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Order.

4 Construction of references to Ministers

In a document, a reference to any Minister of a specified description (other than the Premier, the Minister for Jobs, Investment, Tourism and Western Sydney, the Treasurer, the Minister for Energy and Environment or the Minister for Health and Medical Research) is to be construed as a reference to the Premier.

5 Savings provision

Nothing in this Order affects anything done by a Minister of a specified description before the time at which this Order is published on the NSW legislation website.
